

Proverbs 31 (Bible Reading Plan)

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We can walk in courage and not fear! Because of the cross, the love of Jesus Christ, and His salvation, our hope is in Christ. We can walk in freedom, in courage, as daughters of the King. The Apostle Paul wrote "No, in all these things, we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us" Romans 8:37, (NIV). When it snows, she has no fear for her household; for all of them are clothed in scarlet. 22. She makes coverings for her bed; she is clothed in fine linen and purple. 23. Her husband is respected at the city gate, where he takes his seat among the elders of the land. 24. She makes linen garments and sells them, and supplies the merchants with sashes. 25. She is clothed with strength and dignity; she can laugh at the days to come. 26. She speaks with wisdom, and faithful instruction is on her tongue. 27. She watches over the affairs of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness. 28. Her children arise and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her: 29. "Many women do noble things, but you surpass them all." 30. Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised. 31.
