"Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."

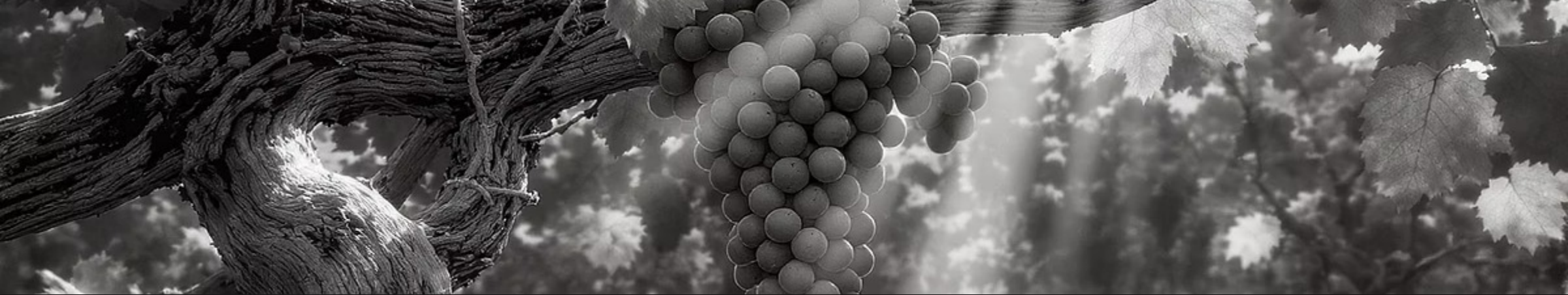
Luke 1:37

Letters to the Corinthians

1 Corinthians 13:4-7

It does not rejoice in evil but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things."
